Get Involved

Be a part of making a difference in our community with us and be proud of the work you do. Our Club serves the community through our fundraising events and projects. We all enjoy the work we do but we also need more people to work with us to help others. Volunteers are always welcome to help out whenever they can.

Events and Projects

The Uxbridge Lions Club operates the Food Booth in Elgin Park. Members and volunteers serve food and beverages to the public during community events such as Cruise In Car Show, Canada Day celebrations, and Fall Fair. During these events there are a combination of at least 8 Lions Club members and volunteers required to serve the public.

Our biggest event every year is Art in the Park, which takes place on the third weekend in August. Artists from all over Southern Ontario come to set up a booth to display and sell their artwork. There is a variety of artwork such as paintings, sculptures, jewellry, and clothing. We host a Silent Auction for which artists will donate a sample of their artwork. Proceeds from the Silent Auction go to the Lions Foundation Canada of Dog Guides.

The Universal Accessible Playground Project was one of our biggest projects in collaboration with the Township of Uxbridge. From the planning drawings to the completion of the playground, it took over 5 years for the playground to evolve. It is very rewarding to see the playground being enjoyed by members of all ages in the community. We are still receiving donations for the playground to obtain more equipment.

Our Club members also participate in an Adopt-a-Road project to pick up garbage along the boulevard on both sides of Toronto Street from Concession 6 to the south entrance to Cemetery Road.

The Uxbridge Lions Club also hosts the Pet Valu Walk for Dog Guides every year on the last Sunday in May. Members of the community are invited to walk their dogs to donate to the Lions Foundation of Canada Dog Guides. Donations from the walk go towards the training of a Dog Guide which takes 2 years and then the individual who will benefit from the Dog Guide is involved in the training. Did you know that someone in Uxbridge actually has a Dog Guide?

Our Club usually does a Road Toll in May and sometimes in September every year. Donations received go back into the community to various non-profit and charitable organizations and towards projects that are beneficial to individuals and families.

Christmas Baskets is another project that our Club does every year. We buy clothing and groceries that are distributed to families in need through the Uxbridge Christmas Hamper Campaign.

We have also done Vision and Hearing Screening in schools for children in junior and senior kindergarten, and in Grade 1.

As well as all these activities, we continue to donate funds to various non-profit and charitable organizations in the Uxbridge area.
